

## THE GARDENS ARE OPEN WITH RESTRICTIONS

- We are operating under our reopening plan that is guided by science and prioritizes the safety, security, and health of our staff, volunteers, and visitors.
- The following requirements follow CDC, Calif. Department of Public Health, and UCR guidelines.
- Our success at remaining open and expanding open days depends on our adherence to these requirements. If you are not comfortable wearing a mask or following these requirements, for the safety of our staff, volunteers, and visitors you will not be permitted to enter.

## Phase 2 Reopening Schedule until further notice

- Due to the need to have gate attendants at all times, open days and hours are currently limited.

- All visitors are expected to exit by the time gates are locked.

## Phase 2 Reopening Requirements

- 1. If you are ill or feel unwell, please do not visit until you have fully recovered.
- 2. To ensure that physical distancing can be maintained, admission may be limited.
- 3. Group size is limited to 10 or fewer.
- 4. Physical distancing of 6 feet from all persons not in your group is required.
- 5. Masks covering both nose and mouth must be worn by each person over the age of 2 whenever you are entering, exiting, using the restroom, and whenever you are unable to maintain a physical distance of 6 feet from persons not in your group.
- 6. Please wear masks and practice physical distancing when approaching others on pathways or trails or in small garden areas.
- 7. Entrance restrooms are open and disinfected regularly; upper restrooms are closed.
- 8. Drinking fountains are closed but bottle hydration stations are open.
